Subject: Conditional Approval Letter to operate trucks through Dec 31, 2014

Dear Mr. Reeve:

Based on Reeve Trucking's commitment to bring their fleet into compliance, the Air Resources Board (ARB) will not take enforcement action against Reeve's or any entity that dispatches Reeve's trucks between the date of this letter and **Dec 31, 2014**. After **Dec 31, 2014**, Reeve's Trucking must provide documentation to the ARB that demonstrates that Reeve's is meeting their compliance commitment. Reeve's agreed to have the fleet 100% compliant by December 31, 2015. Reeve's fleet will be subject to full enforcement action beginning January 1, 2016, or before, if Reeve's compliance commitment is not met.

This letter must be kept in each truck of your fleet in a location known to the driver. The letter must be presented to any ARB enforcement representative upon request.
